This year's SBC is committed to fostering a strong, engaged, and collaborative community that enhances the student experience both academically and socially.


Our newly elected leaders are eager to build upon the foundation set by past councils, working together to create meaningful initiatives and opportunities for all students.


"As the newly elected Student Body Council (SBC) President for the 2025-2026 academic year, I'm honored to serve and advocate for CNUCOM students.

By seeking input from my peers, I hope to implement initiatives that benefit both academic and extracurricular experiences, leaving a lasting impact on CNUCOM."




March 2025 Faculty Spotlight!


